The African Cooperation in Accreditation's Mutual Recognition Arrangement (AFRAC MRA) Committee at its meeting held on 25 September 2018 in Baraclava Fort, Mauritius qualified Mrs Maureen Mutasa (SADCAS) as team leader for peer evaluations. Mrs Mutasa was amongst 3 AFRAC peer evaluators qualified as team leaders.

Mrs Mutasa will be participating in another 2 peer evaluations during the 2018/19 financial year for AFRAC and APLAC respectively.
